## RANGER BASICS INTEREST FORM

Ranger Basics is the new and improved 8 hour course teaching new Royal Ranger Commanders, Councilmen, etc. the basics of Royal Rangers. The course includes an overview and brief history of the Ministry, how to conduct a Royal Ranger Meeting (including a model Outpost Meeting), the Royal Ranger uniform and most importantly, how to lead a boy to Jesus Christ. No pre-requisites or previous preparation is required. Interested Christian men over age 21 (18-21 may be assistant leaders, i.e. Lieutenant Commanders) with a burden to work with boys and approved by your Pastor are qualified to take this course. Women are also eligible to work in the Ranger Kids age level (youngest age level from kindergarten through second grade). A husband and wife team is strongly encouraged also for the Ranger Kid age level. Additional training is available after this Basics course to complete all requirements for your Leaders Medal of Achievement including all areas of the Royal Rangers Ministry from how to conduct a proper Ranger Kids Field Day or an overnighter for the older boys, discipleship, counseling boys, etc.

The course is taught in your local church on a Saturday (8:00 am through no later than 5:00 pm including lunch) by certified instructors as approved and coordinated by the Conference Training Coordinator David Harris (1419 Ford Road, Lot D5, Chapel Hill, NC, 27516) and Conference Commander Michael Hubbard (110 Dry Avenue, Cary, NC, 27511). You simply publicize this training to your local church members for interested persons and discuss the best time to conduct the course at your church. A contact person should be selected (as indicated below) for communication purposes. Other local churches should also be contacted to possibly attend this training if interested. The local church as the training host provides the facility, lunch, publicizes the training, etc. The instructors bring all required materials the day of the training including a workbook and Ranger Basics Patch (for your uniform). The cost for the course is between \$20.00 to \$25.00 which includes the workbook, patch, lunch (as coordinated by the local church host) plus the travel expenses of the instructors.
