Pow-wow General Information

CALLING ALL OUTPOSTS IN OR NEAR THE CORNERSTONE CONFERENCE!

A GREAT CHALLENGE is calling to you to attend the 2008 Cornerstone Conference Pow-wow, 16-18 May 2008 at the Conference Campgrounds at Brown Summit. The Challenge, if you are and of course you are prepared to face, is "Finishing The Race".

This year's theme revolves around a similar structure to the popular television show "Survivor", but most importantly, God's word is very concerned about how we run this earthly race and most of all "Finishing The Race!" We as Christians prepare ourselves everyday physically, socially, mentally and most of all spiritually to meet the challenges of everyday life and living the life God wants us to live. This Pow-wow will also emphasize such challenges from our daily activities / Challenges, campsite preparation, archways and most of all our important time hearing from God during our devotions and Council Fire. Our special guest speaker will be our own Cornerstone Conference C.E.M. Director Joel Boyles! I am anticipating the Holy Spirit's total anointing over the Pow-wow and our Council Fire service! Pray now for a great outpouring over our boys and men!

Challenges

The Pow-wow will be filled with "Challenges" for all Outposts to take part in with the total scores to be added together to decide on the TOP OUTPOST OF THE 2008 POW-WOW! The awards will be held on Saturday night after the Council Fire in a special awards presentation. WHO WILL THE BEST OUTPOST BE??????? All Outposts will be recognized for their effort, however, the top five Outposts will be formally presented at the Awards Ceremony and the top Outpost selected from that group. ALL Challenges must be completed for an Outpost to be considered in the BEST OUTPOST competition. The Challenges cover the basic areas of our camping experience. Each Outpost will take part in the following Challenges.

Campsite Challenge

Each Outpost shall prepare their campsite as if they were to camp for a month period (less the food and supplies needed of course). Be inventive with your campsites and choose some theme related possibilities in your campsites. A Campsite Challenge Judging Form is attached for your use. Note these forms shall be filled in by each Outpost and given to Commander Hubbard as noted for Judging on Saturday morning and afternoon by the pre-selected judging team.

Archway Challenge

Each Outpost shall prepare a main entry Archway identifying their Outpost and may also add theme related design for additional consideration and points. Note the Judges will be reviewing for the best five overall Archways.

Shelter Challenge

This Challenge involves a tent pitching race against the clock. A simple pup tent will be provided already set-up. Each Outpost will take the tent down and then set-up again.

Fire Challenge

This Challenge involves a fire starting race against the clock. Each Outpost will gather fire starting materials found in the general area / site and must be collected when the clock starts. Each Outpost brings their own matches and can use as many as needed. Start the fire and burn a string set at 24" in height.

Orienteering Challenge

This Challenge involves an orienteering race against the clock. Coordinates will be given of certain locations around the campgrounds and each Outpost will locate such objects / locations as required. Requirements and equipment needs will be noted at our opening meeting on Friday night.

Ropcraft / Lashing Challenge

This Challenge involves a race against the clock where a triangular chariot is lashed together and run around a short course pulling one of your Outpost members. Chariot and ropes to be provided.

Physical / Obstacle Course Challenge

This Challenge involves a race on the Obstacle Course against the clock. A minimum of two Outpost members shall run the course and any number of Outposts' members may run the course thereafter with the average of the time of the two selected runners calculated for the overall time for the Outpost.

Cooking Challenge

All Outposts shall prepare a One-pot Meal for the Saturday night Fellowship Meal. Judges will select the top five dishes for bonus points for the overall Best Outpost Award. No limit on what you may prepare. Prepare enough for 2 helpings per person in Outpost plus a few more helpings for visitors, staff and judges. Also bring enough plates, bowls, eating utensils, napkins, drinks, desert, etc. for your Outpost and a few more for visitors, staff and judges.

Challenges begin (Shelter, Fire, Orienteering, Ropcraft and Lashing, Cooking, Physical / Obstacle Course). Campsite and Archway judging begins at 10:00 am through the morning and early afternoon

Begin now to pray and prepare for the best you can be at this Pow-wow!

The registration fee also includes one Pow-Wow patch, a Pow-Wow t-shirt (again by popular demand). We need these Registration forms as soon as possible for t-shirt and patch ordering, activity preparation, etc. planning purposes!
