Bronze Medal Requirements

Effective April 1, 2003, Royal Rangers may earn the Bronze Medal of Achievement. A Royal Ranger may earn the BMA in the sixth grade although numerous requirements must be successfully completed. A Royal Ranger may complete the necessary BMA requirements while participating in either the Adventure Rangers or Expedition Rangers programs. The BMA requirements needed appear in the Adventure Ranger and Expedition Ranger Handbooks.
